WORLD TB DAY – Gujarat has 7th highest number of TB cases

Disease Consumed More Than 14,000 People In 4 Years

As the world observes International Tuberculosis (TB) Day on Thursday, the figures from Gujarat are shocking. Gujarat ranks 7th among Indian states with regard to the number of TB cases recorded. The state also saw more than 14,000 deaths from TB between 2011 and 2014. According to the Union Health Ministry's figures, the state registered 72,554 cases of TB in 2012, 74,086 in 2013, 77,395 in 2014 and 41,461 upto June 2015. These show that the state has been registering more than 70,000 cases every year. The state has also been registering a huge numbers of mortalities, which included 3,950 deaths in 2011, 3,808 in 2012, 4,094 in 2013 and 2,172 in 2014. These added upto more than 14,000 deaths in four years.

Experts believed that early diagnosis, proper medication and consumption of nutritious food help patients to beat TB. Dr. Tushar Patel, a city-based pulmonologist, said many TB cases and deaths in Gujarat occur due to drug resistance, caused by patients discontinuing the proper course of medication. "We have also been registering a unique trend in TB cases, where people in the age group of 25 to 40 are the major sufferers, Patel said. Another city-based pulmonologist, Dr. Hetal Shah said, "Patients tend to discontinue treatment after they begin to feel well enough, but TB can relapse as multi-drug resistant TB, which is more virulent, more difficult to treat and more expensive." "Anti-TB drug resistance arises from improper use of drugs in drug susceptible TB patients. Improper or irrational use often means failure to ensure that patients complete the entire course of treatment," said Dr. Shah. He added, "Once the patient takes the drug for a period of time and then skips it without completing the course, the bacteria in his or her body develop resistance to that particular drug. The drug will then now have no impact on the infection the medication is resumed."
