Villagers fall ill after inhaling gas from chemical factory

Vadodara, February-5

Over a dozen villagers of Pilodara in Jambusar taluka of Bharuch district were admitted to a local hospital after inhaling gas emanating from chemical factory located near their homes in the industrial belt of the district. The affected were complaining of headaches, vomiting and burning sensation in their eyes.

While most of the villagers were relieved from the local referral hospital early on Wednesday morning, two workers employed at the factory had to be rushed to HSG Hospital in Vadodara. Their condition is now stable.
