Bridge Course is to be given at the outset to students enrolling in 'B'Stream. These have different levels of proficency in English and so need to be brought on part. It is suggested to have 21 letures each of 45 minutes, before the beginning of the teaching of regular syllabus. The said course have protest to judge he standard, of the entrants. It should also have post-test to judge the students progress.

The following components and an approximate number of 21 sessions(of 45 minutes each) are suggested, However the teacher would be well advised to lay stress on those items in which the particular group (as should be evidnet from the pretest) is weak.
