(A) Read the following passage carefully and answer the questions given below :
On the death of Alexander - the great, his vast empire was almost immediately broken up into three main divisions. In the East, his General Seleucus Nicator founded an empire comprising Persia, Mesopotamia Syria, and part of Asia

Minor, that is, almost all the area from the Hellespont to the Indus. The capital of this empire was Antioch, which became one of the greatest commercial centres of those times, through which merchandise for Arabia, India and China flower into the Mediterranean.

The second division of the Alexandrian empire was the Graeco – Egyptian kingdom founded by Ptolemy I, another general of Alexander. Its chief city was Alexandria, which with its safe harbour and splendid library, became for a long time the most important centre of Greek civilization and culture in the ancient world.

The third and the smallest division was Macedon, ruled by an Antigonus and his successor, who had partial control over Greece till 146 B.C. In that year Greece was made a Roman province under name of Achaea. Later, both Syria and Egypt were also conquered by the Romans.
