**Problem Based Question****[20]****Q. 1. Case**

A female patient name XYZ, age 48 yrs, complaining of having palpitations and feeling flashes of heat. (since 3 years), has some constricted feeling causing anxiety. Married , resides in pratap nagar, has two daughters 16 and 13 yrs of age, both FTND. Her periods are irregular since 1 year 2-5 days in 2-3 months. LMP 2 months back. She also have a headache at the top of head, and sometimes she feel like she is going to faint and have pain in her tailbone and lower back, especially when she get up from sitting ( since 1 year) Since 7 days, she is having complaining of tonsils, mainly left side of throat which hurts a lot, and it's hard to swallow liquids. The pain gets worse when she drink something hot, or when she swallow anything, even own saliva. It also hurts more when touch the area or put any pressure on it. She feels no interest in interacting with others, is feeling restless and uneasy and doesn't want to be involved in any work. She is very religious. She has good appetite but ometime she feels some gnawing pressure at epigastric region with adequate thirst, she likes sweet more and it causes indigestion sometime and because of that she want loose clothing around her abdomen and she has very unrefreshed sleep ( has frightened dreams which leads her into agony).

On systemic examination her upper part of trachea is very susceptible to touch, and larynx were painful to touch. Left side tonsils seems of dark red colour and pain radiate to left ear. Vitals normal.
