1. Text : Shakespeare As You Like It (A shorter Shakespeare), (OUP)	25 marks
2. Reading and Comprehension : Precise writing of prose passages (Not more than 300 words) of general interest and questions to test inferential and interpretative skills).	12 marks
3. Writing Composition :	
(i) Writing a short composition of not more than 150 words on a given topic or sentence	8 marks
(ii) Letters : Formal leave notes, applications, complaints, letters to the editor etc.	10 marks
4. Speaking : Developing a dialogue on familiar situations.	8 marks
5. Translation : From English into Gujarati or Hindi of a given passage of about 150 words.	7 marks

1. Text : General Questions (1 out of 3)	15 marks
Short Notes (3 out of 5) OR Short Answer Questions (5 out of 10)	25 marks

3. Writing a short composition (Essay)	12 marks
4. Letter Writing / Application	<u>8 marks</u>
