Compulsory English Course for F.Y.B.Sc. Physio. and F.Y.B.Sc. (Nursing) Examinations of March/April, 2002 onwards

1. *Text* : Eight Short Stories : Edited by K. N. Vasudeva Panikkar (Orient Longman)
Note : A question comprising short-answer questions will be set 10 marks
 A question on short notes will be set 10 marks
2. *Writing* : Completing short stories or rearranging sentences in logical sequences 12 marks
 etc. The Teacher will set tasks for the student in the classroom. (For examples, please, refer to the Handbook of August, 1992).
3. *Speaking* : Identification of speech, sounds and practice in pronouncing them with the help of key words. For key words, please, refer to the Handbook of August, 1992.
4. *Grammar and Usage* : It is assumed that students have studied grammar and usage at school. Following items will be revised through the work-book :
 Tenses, Articles, Auxiliaries and Prepositions.
5. *Vocabulary* : Reinforcing the student's knowledge of vocabulary items learned at School.
Note : The teaching and testing will be at the intermediate level.
N.B. : To begin with Bridge Course and only on completion of the Bridge Course the following syllabus should be taught
