Statue of Unity is the statue of one of the most prominent Indian leaders, Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, who is fondly remembered as the Iron Man of India. Located in the Indian state of Gujarat, it stands tall at a height of 182 metres.

PM Modi inaugurated it on 31st October 2018. The date chosen for the inaugural ceremony was special. It was the 143rd birth anniversary of Sardar Patel. As many as 128, 000 tourists visited this monument within 11 days of its inauguration.

A drive 'Statue of Unity Movement' to support the construction of the Statue of Unity was initiated by the state government of Gujarat. It urged the farmers and artisans to donate their old and used equipment. Scrap iron amounting to 135 metric tonnes was collected by the year 2016 with the help of this movement. Out of this, 109 tonnes was used to establish the foundation of the Statue of Unity.

The statue has been constructed on a river island of the name Sadhu Bet, which is 3.5 kilometres downstream of Narmada Dam. The surroundings add to the beauty of this statue.

Statue of Unity has become the pride of the nation within no time. It is the tallest statue in the world and is attracting numerous tourists from around the world.
