During India's struggle for independence, numerous leaders rose to prominence. One of these fearless leaders was Subhas Chandra Bose who was called the "the Iron Man" of India. Subhas Chandra Bose, also known as "Netaji," was born in a Bengali family on January 23, 1897, at Cuttak in Orissa. From the beginning, reading was a passion with Bose and he was greatly influenced by the writings of Swami Vivekananda. He went to England for further studies and on returning to India, went to join Gandhiji. But his ideas did not match with Gandhiji's belief in non-violence.

He was arrested numerous times. On one such occasion when he was under house arrest he escaped via Afghanistan to Berlin and then to Japan. Here within two years, he raised the Indian National Army (INA) or *Azad Hind Fauj*. His purpose was to defeat the British during World War II. In spite of the defeat of the *Azad Hind Fauj*, Netaji won an immortal place in Indian History. "Jai Hind" was his battle cry and he took the nation to great heights. Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose died in a plane crash in 1945.
